These buckets are even 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

Quick-Tach Buckets

When set up, these buckets free up more of the unit's load capacity, enabling it to deal with heavier and larger items. The Quick-Tach can pour items approximately 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are built in a customized fashion to be able to meet the specs of particular models and makes of forklifts.
