Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is more or less thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
